Every day in hometown Nebraska, law officers leave their home and families to perform their duties. Many times the people they deal with are friends or acquaintances.

This happened on September 27, 1964 in Stuart, Nebraska.

51 Year old Marshall Delbert Addison was shot and killed by a father seeking revenge for his son's arrest. Marshal Delbert Addison had arrested the teenager for a traffic violation after giving the boy a warning for the same violation the previous week. The boy's father found Marshall Delbert Addison near the town square and began an argument. The man suddenly pulled out a revolver and shot Marshall Delbert Addison in front of the marshal's wife. Marshall Delbert Addison was transported to Atkinson Hospital where he died in surgery.

Marshall Delbert Addison was survived by his wife and 3 children and many grandchildren that he did not get to see and enjoy grow up.
